

22-18	<p>To consider the proposal to make use of the HRH piano as a ‘community’ piano.</p> <p>It was agreed that a letter will be sent to HBC requesting that they remove the piano as it is owned by them. Depending on their response, further discussion is needed at the next meeting if the piano remains in the Hall.</p>
23-18	<p>To consider the proposal regarding Men’s Sheds</p> <p>It was agreed that the authors of the proposal would be invited to the next HRH committee meeting so that they can view the Hall and discuss the option to use HRH as a venue for a Men’s Shed.</p>
24-18	<p>To consider the following:</p> <p>1. Roof</p> <p>Mr Willis to produce specification for essential roof repair to send out to tender. It was agreed that an inspection of the roof is needed in the first instance to assess the full extent of the repairs needed. Since the costs could be in the region of £40,000, it was agreed that funding should be sought and a discussion took place regarding fund-raising ideas.</p> <p>2. Painting the front of the building</p> <p>Mr Willis to cost up. Work will take place no earlier than May due to waiting for suitable weather conditions.</p> <p>3. Overgrown ivy at the back of the hall</p> <p>Cllr Hardisty offered to carry out necessary work and remove the overgrown ivy by spraying. RCC to cover costs of equipment.</p>
25-18	<p>To consider marketing the Hall and attracting new users.</p> <p>There followed a discussion of how to attract more users to the Hall. Suggestions to follow up were: article in the Gazette, advertising in Review Ripon, increasing FB and website content and frequency,</p>
